

SSA 64 Walden Parkway  
Commission Meeting  
February 7, 2023

The meeting was held at Markland Hubbard, 1739 W. 99th St., and called to order at 9:03 a.m. In attendance were Commissioner Lori Parrett and Morgan Park Beverly Hills Business Association Executive Director Caroline Connors.

The minutes from the previous meeting were available for review and approved in a motion made by Lori Parrett.

Caroline and Lori discussed the process to allow SSA 64 to expire at the end of 2023 and add the properties from SSA 64 to SSA 44 103rd Street/Beverly to create one Special Service Area for the 99th and 103rd streets shopping corridors. Caroline said SSA 64 would continue to receive services throughout 2023 via the current year tax collection. The merged SSA would be called SSA 44 per the city of Chicago Department of Planning and Development and would be created via a reconstitution of SSA 44 103rd Street Beverly, taking place in 2023. The 2024 budget for SSA 44 would include services for both the 99th and Walden and the 103rd and Longwood commercial districts and the funds would be spent equitably.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:37 a.m. in a motion made by Lori Parrett.
